RTD to offer bus shuttle service between Clear Creek•Federal and Wheat Ridge•Ward Road stations Sept. 19 during G Line maintenance

G Line trains will run on normal schedule from Union Station to Clear Creek. Federal Station

DENVER (Sept. 12, 2023) — The <u>Regional Transportation District (RTD)</u> will perform necessary maintenance that will affect commuter rail service Tuesday, Sept. 19 on the G Line between Clear Creek•Federal and Wheat Ridge•Ward Road stations.

The scheduled work will improve reliability and safety along the line. During the work, bus shuttles will be in service to connect customers between affected rail stations.

Customers may board bus shuttles at the following station gates:

- Clear Creek Federal Station Gate C (look for bus shuttle service sign located below the elevator)
- 60th Ave.&Sheridan•Arvada Gold Strike Station Gate A (look for bus shuttle service sign; same gate as Route 51B)
- Olde Town Arvada Gate A (look for bus shuttle service sign; same gate as Route 76B)
- Arvada Ridge Station Gate A (look for bus shuttle service sign)
- Wheat Ridge&Ward Road Station Gate C (bus shuttle service information located below the elevator)

The G Line will operate on its regular, 30-minute schedule between Union Station and Clear Creek•Federal Station. The work will not affect B Line service.

Regular service on the G Line will resume **Wednesday**, **Sept. 20**.

RTD encourages customers to use its <u>Trip Planner</u> and <u>Next Ride</u> web apps to plan a trip and see bus and train locations in real time. Customers may also sign up for <u>Service Alerts</u> for specific route information.
