



RTD A Line weekend service temporarily disrupted between Peoria and Denver Airport stations during maintenance and third-party work

Bus shuttle service will connect customers Saturday and Sunday between affected stations

DENVER (June 12, 2023) — A portion of the [Regional Transportation District \(RTD\)](#)'s A Line service will be supplemented by shuttle buses June 17-18 as lines are de-energized between Peoria and Denver Airport stations.

RTD will perform scheduled inspections and maintenance on the overhead electrical wires that power the agency's commuter rail trains. The shutdown will also accommodate third-party work adjacent to the tracks at Denver Airport Station.

A Line trains will operate as scheduled between Peoria and Denver Union stations. Bus shuttle service will be offered between Peoria and Denver Airport Stations at the following locations:

Denver Airport	Gate 7

Rail service to the airport will resume Monday, June 19.
