## RTD's sales outlet at Downtown Boulder Station temporarily relocated to Boulder Junction at Depot Square Station

Relocation of sales outlet only; bus service not being reinstated at new location

DENVER (Jan. 19, 2023) — Beginning tomorrow, the <u>Regional Transportation District (RTD)</u> will temporarily relocate its Downtown Boulder Station sales outlet to Boulder Junction at Depot Square Station until further notice. The sales outlet's hours of operation will be 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Customers can purchase tickets, access lost and found, and other outlet services including EcoPass issuance. Parking is available in the attached garage.

The move comes as crews remediate the Downtown Boulder Station after discovering traces of methamphetamine in restrooms and the adjacent hallway last week.

For the safety of RTD's customers and employees, Downtown Boulder Station's interior facilities will remain closed until sanitation of the station is completed. Bus service will not be reinstated at Boulder Junction at Depot Square Station, however, some routes have bus stops near the station, such as the <a href="https://example.com/225">225</a>, <a href="Bound">Bound</a> and <a href="Bound">BOLT</a>.
