

## IT'S EASY TO APPLY!

If you are enrolled in Medicaid, SNAP, or Colorado Works, you may already be income-qualified for LiVE enrollment. For detailed instructions, go to rtd-denver.com/LiVE.

- 1 Visit colorado.gov/PEAK to apply for yourself and any other eligible household members.
- 2 Submit qualifying photo(s) (see instructions online), income verification documents, and a mailing address for all applicants.
- 3 Receive your LiVE identification card in the mail and purchase qualifying LiVE fare (pre-paid or mobile ticket) to ride the RTD system.

## **HOW DO I QUALIFY?**

- ✓ Your household income is at or below 185% FPL.\*
  - \*Federal Poverty Level. As of April 2023, monthly income limits are as follows, based on number of household members: \$2,248 (1); \$3,040 (2); \$3,833 (3); \$4,625 (4); \$5,417 (5); \$6,210 (6).
- ✓ You are not eligible for a senior or youth discount.

  RTD has discounted fares for seniors (65+) and youth (19 and younger). Visit rtd-denver.com/discountfares for more information.
- You can provide a valid address. If you don't have an address, local service organizations may be able to accept mail on your behalf.
- You live in the RTD service area. Visit the RTD website for service area maps.
- You can supply household income verification. If you are enrolled in Medicaid, SNAP, or Colorado Works, you may not have to submit income documents.
- You can provide a recent photo. Photos must have neutral backgrounds and show your face clearly, close-up, and in full color.
