RTD Free MallRide stop at Civic Center Station to be temporarily relocated

Customers will board and deboard at alternate locations during concrete repair work

DENVER (June 1, 2022) — The <u>Regional Transportation District</u> (RTD) will temporarily relocate the Free MallRide stop at Civic Center Plaza to complete concrete repairs of the shuttle turnaround. The work will begin Monday, June 6, and is expected to last through early August.

While repairs are being made at Civic Center Station, the turnaround for RTD's Free MallRide will be closed and customers will board and deboard at these alternate locations:

- Customers traveling to Civic Center Station will deboard on 16th Street at Broadway
- Customers traveling to Union Station will board on 16th Street at Court Place
