# Downtown Rail Reconstruction Project

Work is underway on a multi-phased project by the Regional Transportation District (RTD) to improve five intersections in downtown Denver that serve as at-grade crossings for the agency's D, H and L light rail lines.

Construction on 15th Street at the California and Stout intersections wrapped up on Tuesday, Aug. 6. The final intersections included in this project are 17th/California and 17th/Stout.

Work on 17th/Stout and 17th/California is planned to start on Monday, Aug. 12 and last approximately three weeks.

### You can expect:

- Work will occur simultaneously at the intersections of 17th/ Stout and 17th/California streets.
- 17th Street will be closed in two locations:
  - Between California Street and the alley to the east.
  - Between Stout Street and the alley to the west.
- At least one lane will remain open on Stout and California streets at 17th Street.
- Sidewalks and crosswalks will be closed on the east side of California Street and west side of Stout Street.
- Welton Street will continue to operate as a one-way street with two northbound lanes between 15th and 17th streets to accommodate the additional traffic.
- Alley, parking lot, loading dock and parking structure access will remain open.
- All business access will remain open.

### Bus and Rail Impacts

- During the work, the D and H lines will be rerouted to Union Station. The L Line will be suspended, and Bus Route 43 will serve as an alternative.
- The RTD free MallRide will run on 15th and 17th streets between Union Station and Champa Street through this fall.
- RTD has temporarily reinstated the Free MetroRide to expand transit across downtown Denver with all-day, fare-free service along 18th and 19th streets between Union Station and Civic Center Station, seven days a week.
- Bus Route 0L will also provide all-day connections seven days a week between I-25/Broadway and Civic Center stations.
