For the week of January 5, 2025, the Maintenance of Way (MOW) team worked in collaboration with the contracted rail grinder mitigating rail defects in the Southwest corridor between Evans station and Mineral station in the overnight maintenance window. The team also off loaded 2400' of new rail that will be staged for installation in the coming weeks.			
The contracted rail grinder will begin work in the Central Corridor on Sunday January 12 in a full rail shutdown and bus bridge from the Auraria East station to the I-25 & Broadway station. The shutdown schedule is below:
