Work completed in the last week:

This weekly report covers Sunday 4/6/2025 to Friday 4/11/2025.

MOW installed 120' of rail near the Auraria West station during the three-day OCS repair shutdown in the Central Platte Valley corridor. Also, track welding was performed on the Southwest corridor between Littleton Downtown and Mineral stations.

In addition, the SCADA team performed a successful fiber pull to replace degrading fiber in the Central Platte Valley corridor during this shutdown.

No slow zones were removed this week.

Rail distribution, replacement, ballast work, and slow zone mitigation will continue Sunday April 13 in the Southeast, Southwest and Parker Road (R-Line) corridors.
