History

Developing the proposed Diagonal Flyer service

- 2013 2014 Northwest Area Mobility Study (NAMS) prioritizes this corridor for bus rapid transit service
- 2018 2019 Planning and Environmental Linkages Study (PEL) identifies two route patterns for service between Longmont and Boulder
- 2020 2023 CDOT multimodal corridor and engineering design underway; RTD implements two surveys for bus service feedback
- 2024 Community and CU Boulder feedback confirms final orange pattern route; RTD hosts meetings with technical advisory group

Technical Advisory Group


- RTD convened a technical advisory committee comprised of members of the Boulder, Longmont, the University of Colorado Boulder, and Boulder Chamber
- Committee met five times between October 2024 and March 2025
- Committee provided feedback and insights to develop proposed route patterns, stops, and service frequency



Route Patterns

Diagonal Flyer route names

- RTD proposes two route patterns for the Diagonal Flyer
 - Route BOLT would be renamed Diagonal Flyer 1 (DF1) with service
 from Park Ridge Main Street to Downtown Boulder Station via 28th Street
 - Route is blue on proceeding maps
 - The Diagonal Flyer 2 (DF2) would replace former Route J service from Park Ridge
 Main Street to Baseline
 Broadway via Boulder Junction
 Depot Square Station
 - Route is orange on proceeding maps



- Spacing of stations and stops based on national BRT guidelines
- Six PnR's (+1 future new PnR at Park Ridge Main, Longmont)
- Nine main stations
 - Longmont: 3
 - Trunk line: 3
 - Boulder: 3
- Improvements at stops along both patterns



Potential Opening Day Service Level Scenarios

Potential opening day service level scenarios

This document presents proposed operating timespans and service frequencies for RTD's Diagonal Flyer routes, DF1 and DF2, on their launch day. The DF1 will replace the current BOLT bus service, while the DF2 will take over Route J, which was suspended in 2020.

Service Level 1 aligns with RTD's System Optimization Plan (SOP), which recommends adjustments to bus and rail services to enhance regional mobility. Under this scenario:

DF1: Doubles current BOLT schedule frequency between 6 AM – 9 PM on weekdays, and 6 AM – 6 PM on Saturdays.

DF2: Provides at a minimum the same level of service as former Route J, operating bi-directionally in AM and PM peaks on weekdays.

Level 2 and Level 3 service frequency scenarios for opening day will be determined based on demand and available resources at the time of the applicable Runboard/Service Change Public Process.
