No cost fare program for customers ages 19 and under now permanent

YOUR CITY (Aug. XX, 2024) — The [Regional Transportation District \(RTD\)](#)'s Board of Directors approved continuing the Zero Fare for Youth program beyond the agency's one-year pilot. The program, which enables youth ages 19 and under to use all RTD services at no cost, will now become a permanent fare change for the agency.
